



Senior Consultant on Construction Permits

Trade and Competitiveness Global Practice (T&C GP) of the World Bank is seeking to recruit an outstanding Senior Consultant on Construction Permits to work on the World Bank program in Poland.

The Consultant will provide first-hand, practical know-how on administrative processes and service improvements in issuing construction permits and other construction-related approvals as well as facilitate knowledge exchange between most efficient cities in Poland and development partners in the Świętokrzyskie and Podkarpackie voivodships.

The position entails travel to Rzeszow, Kielce, and potentially other cities in Poland. The consultant will interact with officials and business representatives in these cities.

The position requires a minimum of a Master's degree in engineering, city planning, architecture or a related field, with at least 10 years of professional experience (preferably in managing construction permits), superior technical skills (including proficiency in using MS Office), first-rate interpersonal and communication skills (fluency in spoken and written English and Polish), ability to work independently and in a team.

This appointment is through a short-term consultancy contract of up to 15 days till December 31, 2016 and may be extended, if needed. The consultant can perform the above duties while continuing her or his current employment, provided that it is not related to administering/implementing "Part II Europe 2020 Programmatic Single-Donor Trust Fund".
